

Acknowledging Him – Powerfully,
“Hallowed be Thy Name”.... 6:9c

Revolution: *“a sudden, radical, or complete change; a change of paradigm.”*

God’s names represent who He is – His character, plan, His provision, and His will for our lives. God reveals His nature so we can understand His completeness!

We are to acknowledge God for who He is! **Understanding this and making it personal unlocks the secret to prayer and life!**

It’s a fact God is Holy!

- ‘Hallowed’ means to acknowledge, to sanctify, to revere, to honor, or to keep holy.

Elohim – is used 2,570 times and refers to God’s power and His might.

Genesis 1:1 - “In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.”

Psalms 19:1 - “The heavens declare the glory of God.”

Adonai – means ‘Master, Lord over all creation.’

Jehovah – Occurs some 6,823. “The self-existent One”

- Tsidkenu – Our righteousness, Jer. 23:6
- Shammah – Our present Lord, Ez. 48:35
- Rapha – Our Healer, Ex. 15:26
