Strength Training - accepting their uniqueness

Proverbs 22:6

“Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it” (ESV)

1st - This is a proverb, not a promise.

2nd – We need to understand the original Hebrew phrase.

Self-Worth / Self Esteem - affirming their value

Matthew 10:29-31

“What is the price of two sparrows – one copper coin? But not a single sparrow can fall to the ground without your Father knowing it. And the very hairs on your head are all numbered. So don’t be afraid; you are more valuable to God than a whole flock of sparrows.” (NLT)

How we do it

- **Paying attention to them.**
- **Show affection to them.**
- **Expressing appreciation.**
- **Don’t emphasize the Killer B’s** – beauty, brains, bucks..
- **Teach them the Eternal C’s** – Christ likeness, commitment, & conviction.
